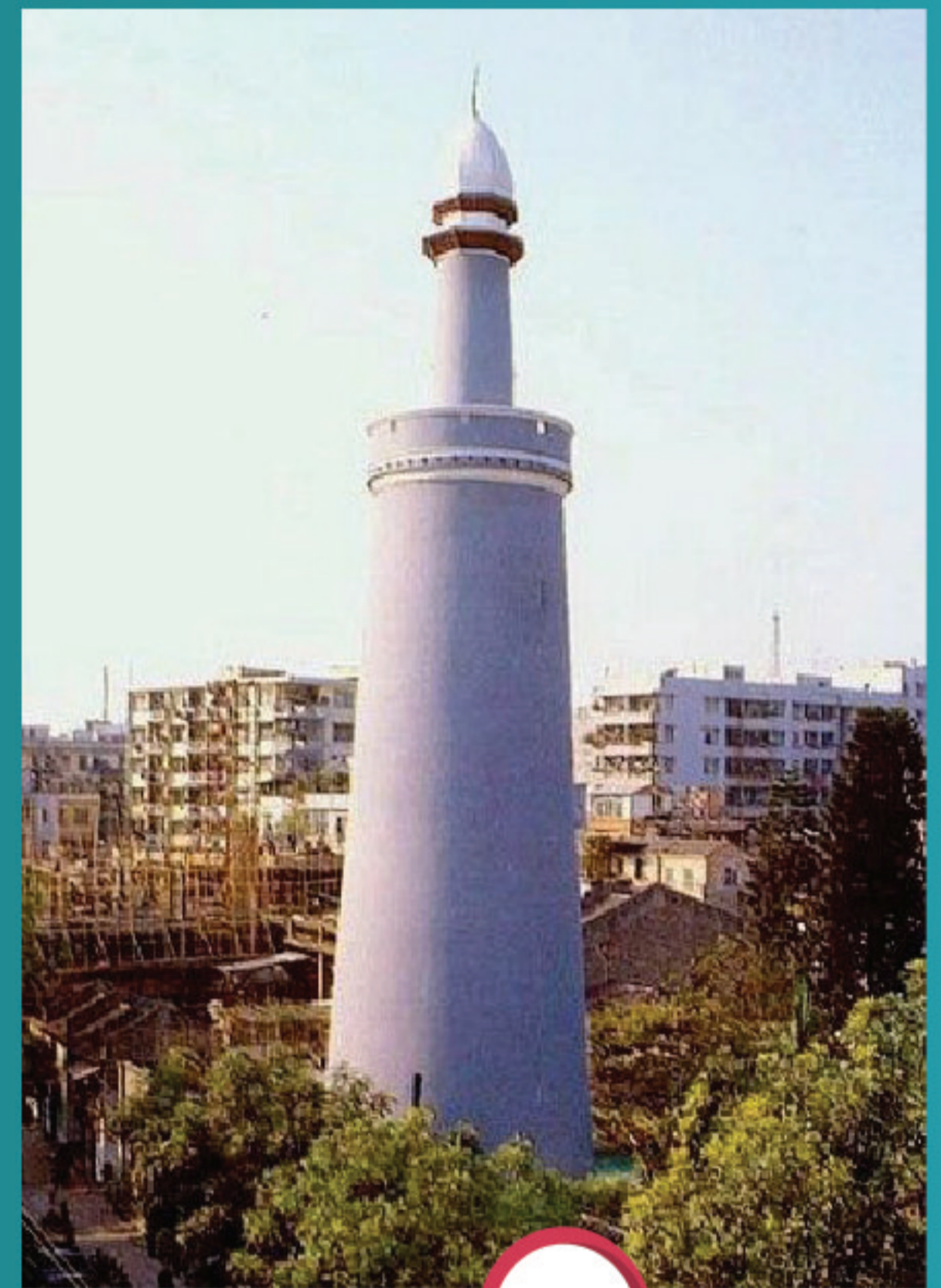


HIST3126 MID IMPERIAL CHINA
